HB 1431 - Allow purchase of health insurance from any of the 50 states, licensed insurance companies, and require policies to be in plain English

HB 1444 - Enable Purchasing Prescription Drugs From Outside the Country

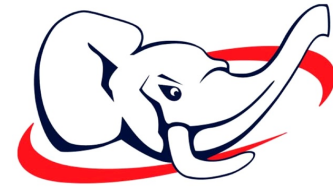

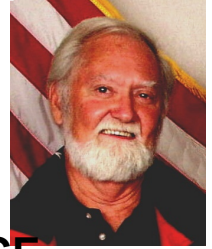
